

Rocky's Rescue Terms and Conditions

Please read carefully our Terms and Conditions and tick the box at the end to say you have read and fully understood them.

- The adoption fee is £500 which is a deposit of £250 to reserve the dog of your choice then the balance of £250 is payable 10 days prior to the dog's departure. Should you change your mind prior to the 10 days before the dog is due to travel the deposit will be non-refundable. If within the 10 days prior to travel, the full amount will be non-refundable as costs will be incurred for internal transport and fostering.
- All dogs are microchipped, vaccinated, treated for flea and worm, arrive with a passport and the fee includes transport to the UK.
- All dogs are health checked prior to leaving the country of origin.
- All adoptions are subject to a home check by a member of Rocky's Rescue team or an independent voluntary home check team.
- We judge each application on an individual basis, we ask that the dogs are not left for any longer than 4 hours especially during their transition period, if this was to be the case, we require that a dog sitter/walker or family member would check on the dog if you work full time. The dog sitter/walker details would need to be provided.
- We need to ensure that you can cope financially with the cost of a dog so they have a good quality of life. We therefore require details of employment.
- We will provide you with as much of the dog's history as we can.
- We do not rehome our dogs to be used for breeding, guarding or anything other than to be a family pet.
- We do not rehome our dogs to families with children under the age of 7 unless there is an existing dog in the house when we will then consider the application.
- The new adopters are not allowed to rehome the dog themselves; the dog must come back to Rocky's Rescue. Please contact us immediately if you are no longer in a position to keep the dog so we can arrange foster care as quickly as possible.
- The new adopter must be aware that we will do our best to match them with the most suitable dog and that they will not meet the dog before taking ownership unless the dog is in foster care in the UK, when at least 2 meetings with the dog and fosterers is required.
- New owners must advise us immediately of any change in circumstances which would mean the dog's needs are not being met.
- Adopters agree to us keeping in touch with them and will provide updates and photos from time to time.
- The need for insurance is essential as Rocky's Rescue will not be held responsible for any vet bills.
- We have the right to send a home checker to do a follow up visit to check that the dog's welfare is being met as we see fit.
- We have the right to remove a dog if we believe they are being mistreated in any way.

Once we receive your adoption application, if successful you will be emailed by a member of the Rocky's Rescue team arrange a home check. If you are successful with your home check and wish to proceed, we will require the non-refundable deposit of £250 to secure the dog of your choice.
